


## **Fitting a Trickle Vent**

## Internal

- 1. Place the unit to the internal side of the door centrally over the routed slot in the frame; this has the section that can be opened.
- 2. The unit can be mounted so as to deflect the airflow upwards or downwards, we recommend mounting the unit to deflect the air upwards.
- 3. Whilst holding the unit in position, mark the frame through the screw hole in the unit with a pencil or similar marker. Remove the unit and drill a suitable pilot hole for the screws.
- 4. Fix the unit to the frame using the screws supplied.
- 5. Once fixed, slide the end caps over the ends of the unit to cover the screws.

## **External**

1. The external hood is supplied with two sets of end caps depending on whether a slim unit is required or a unit with narrow height (see below)



The unit comes supplied as Option 1, if Option 2 is required then simply unclip the Option 1 end plates and replace them with the Option 2 end plates supplied in the bag.

- 2. Once the end plate option has been selected, position the unit centrally over the routed slot and mark through the screw holes with a pencil or similar marker. Remove the unit and drill a suitable pilot hole for the screws.
- 3. Fix the unit on to the frame using the screws provided.
- 4. Once the unit is fixed into place, press the plastic screw covers into position to cover the screws.
